POWER LOUNGES to Open in Haneda Airport Domestic Terminals 1 and 2 on Thursday, April 27

As part of its ongoing renovation works, Japan Airport Terminal Co., Ltd. will open two new fee-charging lounges inside the secure areas of Haneda Airport Domestic Terminals 1 & 2 on Thursday, April 27.


The name of the new lounges will be POWER LOUNGE, based on a concept of “empowerment.” They will provide a space for passengers, whether traveling on business or holiday, to get work done in a vibrant atmosphere or to relax and recharge.

The staff uniforms have been redesigned in line with the new concept, and the services will also be revamped in a way that will give the guests “power” to go about their trips. The new services include an information corner to introduce regional products, a drinks counter in a “kitchen-counter” style, where guests can ask the friendly staff to prepare their drinks, and, in a first for any airport in Japan, a S-MART PICKUP service, in which guests’ gifts can be arranged at the lounge.

Haneda Airport’s other Airport Lounges will also be progressively converted to the POWER LOUNGE format.
